



World ATM Congress 2020 Call for Proposals for inclusion in FABEC OPS Theatre 2020 agenda

3 December 2019: World ATM Congress has partnered with Functional Airspace Block Europe Central (FABEC) for the third year in succession to host the FABEC OPS free education theatre at World ATM Congress 2020 on 10-12 March 2020 at IFEMA, Feria de Madrid in Madrid, Spain. Participants are invited to submit proposals for the 2020 agenda that address operational topics driving air traffic management (ATM) business on a day-to-day basis.

FABEC OPS Theatre is an established forum for discussion and debate on topics that affect airspace management performance. Previous events have explored ATM challenges including managing air traffic volatility, unpredictable and severe weather, and the positive and negative effects of fragmentation. Proposals for the 2020 agenda will continue to investigate effective ways to deliver safe and efficient air traffic services.

Proposals are invited across a variety of topics ranging from case studies that share best practice and operational experience, to cross-border initiatives and collaborative arrangements supporting new operations and procedures. They will highlight achievements and address areas of complexity to improve overall passenger experience.

Please submit your proposal as an abstract of no more than 500 words, detailing presentation titles, content outline, and names of participating organisations by **13 January 2020** to World ATM Congress to the email below. Notice of acceptance is 20 January 2020.
